Koalas look a little like teddy bears, but they are, actually, not bears but marsupials. Like other marsupials, the female has a pouch where she carries her baby, called a joey, for several months after birth. When the joey is strong enough to cling to its mother's back, it leaves the pouch but still sticks its head in to drink milk.

Koalas have soft, wool-like fur that is grey above and white below. Their fur is mostly white on the underside below the neck and their ears have long white hairs on the tips. Koalas are rather small, round animals. They weigh about thirty pounds and on an average grow to be two feet tall. Active and awake during the night, most koalas sleep up to sixteen hours a day.

Koalas are fussy eaters. They eat only eucalyptus leaves and nothing else. There are hundreds of different types of eucalyptus, but koalas eat only about twelve types.

And koalas do not eat every leaf of the branch. They choose the ones that are the freshest.

Eighty percent of koala habitat has been lost due to human population, drought and fires. Koalas are at risk when they are close to human populations. Although they can live up to 17 years, many are killed by cars or dogs. Many people are working together to protect koala habitats and help these cuddly looking creatures survive.
